Here are the common queries we received regarding the **Australian Certificate IV in Training & Assessment (TAE40116)**



Are there any entry requirements for this qualification?

Yes. You are required to be able to demonstrate vocational competency in the proposed teaching and assessing area which translates to a qualification or statement of attainment or that you have industry knowledge and experience.

How long would it take to complete the qualification?

The program is delivered in 4 clusters, and the candidate may complete the clusters in any order e.g. Delivery & Facilitation (4 days), Learning Design Cluster (2 days) Language Literacy & Numeracy (1 day) and Assessment Cluster (3 days). The expected time for a participant to complete the Certificate IV course, depending on prior skills and knowledge is 6 -12 months.

Are there any exams to pass at the end or at every cluster?

There are no exams. The candidate will need to complete the Learning Activities and Assessment for each cluster. The Learning Activities will involve accessing webinars and podcasts, then answering some questions on the webinar/ podcast. The Assessment will involve answering the knowledge questions and completing the assignment projects.
